KRDS (formerly KZON) broadcasts from Tolleson, although its business offices are located in Phoenix. Tolleson is just outside Phoenix.


The station letterhead is still in the works consequently was not available for this reply. No coverage maps are available as yet.



We thank you for your latter to us in connection with our equipment tests last week. Please forgive me for this impersonal method of replying (the mail has me somewhat "snowed" under). I hope that you will accept this note as verification of your reception -everything checks perfectly with what we sired August 2 ., 1961.

We will be a daytime 50 KW and we should get approval sometime the latter part of the week to start our regular broadcast schedule. Later this year -- or perhaps not until next year -- we hope to be on fulltime. probably 5 or 10 KW nightime.

Our tower is 350 feet in height and is located some 7 miles north of our studio here in Tucson.
