This letter is official verification #2 of the reception of HCFV1 , Canal Tropical, as received by you October 31 in Houston. The details of your written report clearly identified our format type, and your tape was definite proof of your reception of the "Patricio Moncayo Show" which runs from Midnight to 8 AM.

Canal Tropical operates on a frequency of 805 kHz with a power output of 1,250 watts into a vertical radiator, which is shared in Duplex operation by Radio Musical-570. Transmitters are locally constructed using 2 pairs of 4-400A's in final and modulator stages respectively.

You will be interested to know that you were in tune with Quito's most popular station...Canal Tropical is proud to state that its audience is more than three times as large as that of the next station.
